Episode 4: "On the Trail to Trollhalla!" or "Billy of the Apocalypse"

Rogue bear causes camping disaster!

Tragedy occurred at Camp Glass Pond campgrounds, when a bear caused a chain of events which ultimately ended with a natural gas explosion. Campers had been menaced by a large bear trying to force its way into the cabins, when the state police showed up to put the dangerous animal down. It is unclear exactly what happened at this time, but it appears that a natural gas tank got ruptured causing a massive explosion and forest fire which killed a dozen police officers and an unknown number of campers.

Log:

May 15, 1955, morning

Agent Coleson calls while Grampa Gunderson is on phone duty, resulting in a ten-minute wait, until Ramio decides he should take over. Coleson informs Ramio that there's been a UFO crash at Camp Glass Pond (which is definitely NOT Crystal Lake), and a large group of hostile aliens has been attacking the police who investigated. The family loads up a bunch of gear, and a drunken Felix, and spends three hours on the two-hour drive.

May 15, 1955, afternoon

After speaking briefly with the police at a nearby roadblock, who point out that the aliens have blockaded the camp's driveway with overturn cars, and that the aliens appear to be extremely resistant to bullets. Ramio scouts out the aliens and Grampa drives the Gundersonmobile up close to the barricade, while Billy blasts the aliens with FEAR, which results in all but two of the aliens running off. The two remaining aliens prove to be trolls, as they are shot by a less than sober Felix really, really well but regenerate and stand up quickly afterwards, and start smashing up the Gundersonmobile rather thoroughly. Ram is ambushed by a couple of shotgun wielding trolls in the woods who, despite being completely unskilled in the use of firearms, proceed to shoot the hell out of him. Billy drops a huge, huge explosion of fire on the trolls, and the group pulls back to reconsider their actions.

The group pulls back up the road, where Grampa Gunderson uses a portable tool kit (that every tool man brings with him) to fix up his car a bit, Felix drunkenly sobs about the lost love that drove him to drink (this time), Billy rests (after having overexerting himself), and Ramio takes it upon himself to scout from the air. Ramio finds camp Glass Pond, with a huge flying saucer crashed in the lake! The camp itself has a gigantic bonfire in the middle of the cabins, several of them burnt down and several others blocked off. Around the bonfire danced a dozen trolls, and some sort of gigantic humanoid made of fire! Ramio heads back to the group, and they put their head together to come up with a plan. Multiple gasoline bombs are bought, with the intention of Ramio dropping them on trolls.

In the end, several flares are fired off, and eight trolls come rushing through the forest towards the party. In one fiery, fell swoop the trolls are finished off between gas bombs, Billy's explosions, and Photon helmet blasts. When the group heads back to the camp to confront the fiery humanoid and remaining trolls, they only find the humanoid. The fiery humanoid proves immune to bullets, but Grampa Gunderson quickly blasts it apart with his photon helmet. When the party goes to investigate the cabins, they are ambushed by the invisible and hidden trolls, as well as the fire giant mage who had been hiding in the bonfire this whole time. In short order the entire party, as well as the car (as well as Grampa's photon helmet), is beat up, so the group retreats again. The party decides to recuperate and repair, before returning for round two. The group sees the remaining trolls preparing to cook several children, so Billy decides those kids are a lost cause and drops a major explosion on them, incinerating the trolls and the children. The giant gets put down shortly thereafter. Ramio briefly explores the flying saucer, discovering a crying computer, but the group decides to let the MCB deal with weird shit at this point, and calls in to the MCB, before receiving a large bounty.
